

## INVITATION TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals for the construction of the Tennis Stadium Improvements SBC No. 540/09-22-07 at The University of Tennessee Knoxville will be received until 2:00 p.m. local time on September 9, 2008 at which time bids will be publicly opened and read at The University of Tennessee, Division of Facilities Planning, 5723 Middlebrook Pike, Suite 119, Knoxville, Tennessee 37996-0040. The bid time shall be established by the timepiece of the Owner's representative.

Two sets of Contract Documents may be obtained by General Contractors by depositing a check in the amount of \$500.00 made payable to Sparkman & Associates Architects, Inc. Deposits will be refunded to General Contractors, provided a bonafide bid is received and the contract documents returned in good condition within ten (10) days after the opening of bids. Subcontractors may obtain one set of Contract Documents by depositing a check in the amount of \$250.00 under the same conditions as indicated for General Contractors. A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 2:00 p.m. local time on August 21, 2008 at The University of Tennessee, Division of Facilities Planning, 5723 Middlebrook Pike, Suite 119, Knoxville, Tennessee 37996-0040.

Bidders must be licensed in the State of Tennessee, as required by the Contractor's Licensing Act of 1976, as amended. Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond or certified check made payable to The University of Tennessee, in an amount equal to 5% of the bid, will be required. No bidder may withdraw its bid within 60 days after the actual opening thereof. The successful bidder will be required to execute a Contract Bond covering and including payment of labor and material, in an amount equal to 100% of the bid as accepted. All bidders shall pay not less than the prevailing wage rates of wages as required by the Contract Documents.
